Where: Schalmont High School

1 Sabre Drive (off Duanesburg Road)

Schenectady, NY 12306

Take Exit 25A from the NYS Thruway to I-88, then take Exit 25 (first exit); at top of ramp, turn left and proceed to traffic light; turn left onto Duanesburg Road; school is at next traffic light.

When: Saturday, November 2, 2024 10:00 am to 3:00 pm

<u>Set-up:</u> Set up begins at 8:00 am. Two chairs will be provided per space. You will need to bring your own table(s) and table covering. **Tables must be draped to the floor on 3 sides.** Student volunteers will assist <u>beginning at 8:00 am</u>.

<u>Breakdown</u>: Breakdown <u>MAY NOT</u> begin <u>before 3:00 pm</u>. Again, we will try to have student volunteers available to assist.

Registration: Registration deadline is October 14, 2024 or until filled.

A **non-refundable fee of \$40.00** for each space (approximately 8 ft x 10 ft); **electricity** is available on a first-come, first-served basis for an additional **fee of \$3.00**.

<u>Publicity</u>: Pertinent information will appear in the community section of the local news websites, on all Schalmont social media sites, paid advertising will appear in local newspapers. Prominent signs will be displayed in front of the high school, at local busy intersections and at the "five corners" intersection prior to the fair.

<u>Items</u>: All items for sale MUST demonstrate some type of handcrafting by the craft person on the item. <u>No vendors, flea market or garage sale items will be allowed.</u> We reserve the right to approve craft items. Craft categories will be taken based on your registration date with the attempt to avoid too many crafters in one category.

<u>Refreshments</u>: Concession items will be sold for breakfast and lunch. One complementary cup of coffee and doughnut will be provided for each booth, and there will be volunteers to serve refreshments for your convenience. We request that you be cheerful with our volunteers.

<u>General</u>: Booth space against the wall may be requested and all spaces will be assigned on a **first-come**, **first-served basis**. Booth locations will be based on your registration date and at the discretion of the Craft Fair Committee. Confirmations will be made during October; at that time you will receive detailed instructions for parking and booth location. <u>If possible, confirmations will be emailed to you so please provide a working email address if that is possible.</u>
